



## **2016 Oswego Speedway DEMO DERBY Rules and Regulations**

Saturday, July 16 – FOLLOWING the Feature Events

**Driver's Entry: NOTE: Officials have the right to accept or reject any and all applications.**

1. Drivers must be 16 years of age or older. Drivers under the age of 18 must have a signed parental consent form by both parents.
2. You must fill out an entry form prior to the Derby. There is NO entry fee.
3. You must supply your own car for the event. The Speedway will provide a service to remove cars. You are encouraged to leave your car at the Speedway, following the event.

**SAFETY AND CAR INSPECTIONS:** No commercial vehicles, including limos, hearses, ambulances or Chrysler Imperials or Imperial frames 1973 or older. No trucks, vans, or station wagons. Any two or four door hardtop car is allowed. This will be a big car Derby. Big cars classified as those having six or eight cylinder engines. All vehicles must have a minimum 100" wheelbase. Cars must remain stock. No 4WD vehicles allowed unless the front or rear wheel drive shafts have been removed. We reserve the right to drill holes in any part of the car during inspection; we reserve the right to inspect all winning cars. All airbags must be removed. All cars that do not meet inspection will be loaded. NO ALCOHOLIC beverage consumption allowed. Any driver or crew member found consuming alcohol or determined to be under the influence will be banned from the pits.

**BUMPERS/ENGINE MOUNTS:** Any OEM CAR bumper is permitted. They may not be altered in any way. No reinforcing of bumpers or engine mounts.

**HELMETS AND SAFETY BELTS:** All drivers must wear an approved SNELL or DOT full face helmet with shield or safety glasses. This should also have a chin wraparound. Safety belts are required. Shoulder harness must be a quick release. If a shoulder harness needs to be added to the vehicle it should be bolted through the roof. Drivers mandated to wear a fire suit or coveralls. Neck protector highly recommended.

**FIRE EXTINGUISHER:** A fire extinguisher is recommended for each car. Those that do not have a fire extinguisher must notify an official prior to the start of the event.

**ROLL OVER BARS/HALO BARS:** A four-point is recommended but not required. If using a dash bar and seat bar (bar running behind driver's seat they must be attached to the solid part of the pillars and not to the doors sheet metal. Roof bars are allowed but must come off the seat bar and must go straight up, across and bolt in three spots across roof.

**FRAME AND SUSPENSIONS:** No welding, cutting or alteration of frames or sub-frames or suspensions. Car must

have factory and free-moving suspension. No reinforcing frame.

**GLASS:** All glass must be removed - NOT broken out, including headlights, taillights and sunroof. All glass edges must be removed. Any loose or broken glass found in the car will result in immediate disqualification. Front windshield must have a mesh wire or screen in place of the windshield glass.

**GASOLINE/FLUIDS:** NO MORE THAN THREE (3) GALLONS IS PERMITTED IN TANK. Gas tanks may remain in original position and may be chained or wired or strapped in place. There must be a firewall between the gas tank and the driver. NO LEAKING GAS TANKS ALLOWED. If using a stock tank, a metal screw must be placed in the tank in order for officials to check fuel capacity. The screw must be inserted on the side of the tank no more than 3 inches up from the bottom of the tank. ALL antifreeze must be drained and replaced with water.

**DOORS:** The driver's side door must be welded shut. All remaining doors are to be chained or welded shut. If the door comes open, the car will be disqualified.

**COSMETICS:** Wheel covers, sharp hood ornaments, mirrors, antennas, and ALL chrome and plastic molding, including grills, must be removed. Protruding tail fins must be bent over. All loose materials must be removed from the car. Any sharp objects on or along the sides of the car must be removed or smoothed off. Profanity, obscene pictures or wording painted on vehicles is strictly prohibited. Rear seat, rearview mirror and sun visor must be removed. Any holes in floor must be covered with metal.

**TIRES:** All-season tires only, not to exceed 6 ply. No snow, studded or aggressive tread tires allowed. The tires must be filled with air only and no modifications may be made to the tires or rims. No tires inside of tires will be allowed.

**TRAILER HITCHES:** All trailer hitches must be removed, including all added hitch brackets. No exceptions, no excuses.

**HOOD:** All vehicles must have a 12" hole cut over the carburetor or throttle body. Hold-down springs and/or shocks must be removed. Hinges are to remain hooked up. Releases are to be replaced with two (2) hood pins or seat belted, but NOT chained, wired, welded or bolted down due to fire regulations. The hood must be able to open freely. All vehicles must start the Derby with a hood.

**TRUNK:** Hold down springs and shocks must be removed. Trunk latches must be removed. Any vehicles with any compartments must leave accessibility for inspection. It may be welded down with three (3) inch weld on each side. There must be a twelve (12)" hole in the center of the trunk. All Vehicles must start the Derby with a trunk.

**ELECTRICAL UNITS:** Batteries 12 volt only, solenoid and voltage regulators may be relocated, provided they remain under the hood and forward of the firewall and not enclosed in any way. No open wires will be allowed.

**ENGINES:** Engine may be independently mounted to the frame. You cannot strengthen any other component by mounting to the motor. Fan blade must be removed unless it is protected by the radiator fan shroud. All engine parts must remain stock with carburetor and air filter intact. Exhaust pipes must remain stock and may not be shortened.

**(GENERAL CONDUCT/INFORMATION):**

1. Demolition derby cars are to remain completely stock except for alterations to comply with safety rules. Any parts considered not to be stock will result in disqualification.
2. Drivers are encouraged to have sponsors and car numbers. Car numbers will be provided on a first come first serve basis. No duplicate numbers allowed. Anyone arriving with a duplicate number will have to add another single digit to their number.
3. NO crashing into driver's side door at any time.
4. NO excessive spinning of rear wheels after car is stuck in one spot and tires are flat. Subject to immediate disqualification.
5. Anyone involved in fighting or abusive action will be arrested. NO warnings.
6. Any dead heat or tie will result in splitting the prize money.
7. All cars competing in the demolition derby must be at the Speedway by 4pm on Saturday, July 16 for pre-derby inspection. All competitors and crew members are required to purchase a pit pass.
8. Oswego Speedway tech inspectors have the right to reject any entry.
9. Speedway management and tech inspectors reserve the right to change any rule up to the time of the event.
10. All decisions are final and not subject to protest.
